## RULES & INFO

- Proof of negative coggins required upon arrival
- \*\*Veterans show free with proof of ID (excluding shavings and stall)\*\*
- All bills must be paid, or open check left before receiving back number
- \* = pattern class
- Schooling in show pen 7-8 AM
- Walk/Trot exhibitors cannot cross enter any loping or cantering classes
- Horses can cross enter W/T & loping/cantering classes with different exhibitors
- Cross entries of Western Pleasure & Ranch Pleasure classes are not allowed
- Youth must be 18 or younger as of January 1<sup>st</sup>
- ASTM helmets must be worn in hunt seat & fun classes
- Western hat or ASTM helmets must be worn in western classes
- Horses must be shown in discipline appropriate tack
- Will follow legal equipment as provided in AQHA rule book
- Any age horse can be ridden in a snaffle
- Trail can be shown in western or hunt seat tack/attire
- Ribbons awarded 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place
- **JACKPOT PAYOUT:** For classes with 6 or more entries: \$10 of entry goes to payout 1<sup>st</sup> at 60%, 2<sup>nd</sup> at 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10%. For less than 6 entries 1<sup>st</sup> will be paid 100%. Jackpot checks will be mailed up to two weeks after the show.
